

Employment issued the period applicability for EPF reduction from 12% to 10% as May, June and July 2020. The establishments registered under the Act other than Government enterprises / establishments and establishments already seeking relief under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojna, the contribution which shall be paid by the employer to the EPF shall be Ten percent. The employee's contributions shall be equal to the employer's contribution payable in respect of wages payable to employees for May, June, July 2020. Download
