As per the notification, the Government of India, as part of taking various measures towards the management of COVID-19, has issued standard operating procedures on preventive measures to contain the spread of the same in offices, religious places / places of worship, hotels, and other hospitality units, restaurants, shopping malls. States/UTs are requested to implement the same. However, they may develop and implement their protocol, which may be stricter as per their assessment of the situation to contain COVID-19 effectively.

Additional Order Regarding Lockdown Of Certain Sectors In Odisha

As per the notification, Government of Odisha, the Ministry of Home Affairs issues an order on 30th May 2020, as the States/ UTs, based on their assessment of the situation, are authorized to prohibit certain activities outside the Containment Zones or to impose such restrictions as deemed necessary from time to time, the Government of Odisha have directly specified that A) All Religious Places/ Places of Worship for Public will continue to remain closed till 30th June 2020. B) All Shopping Malls will continue to remain closed till 30th June 2020. C) Restaurants and Hotels will be permitted for home delivery/takeaways of food, including home delivery of food by aggregators such as Zomato, Swiggy, etc. till 30th June 2020.
